

CROCHET DICE PATTERN FOR BABIES AND TODDLERS

10 cm x 10 cm White Dice (Black Dots)



MATERIALS

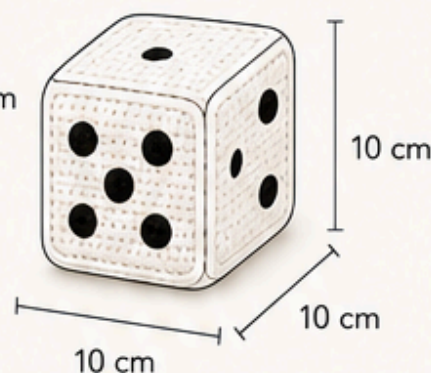
- DK cotton yarn (white & black)
- 2.5 mm crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Stitch marker (optional)
- Toy stuffing
- Small rattle insert (optional)
- Scissors

ABBREVIATIONS (UK TERMS)

- ch** = chain
- dc** = double crochet
- sl st** = slip stitch
- inc** = 2 dc in same stitch
- st(s)** = stitch(es)

FINISHED SIZE

Approximately
10 cm x 10 cm x 10 cm



STEP 1 – MAKE 6 SQUARES

ROW 1

- Chain 21.
- Work 1 dc into the second chain from the hook.
- Continue working 1 dc in each chain across.
- 20 stitches**

ROWS 2–20

- Chain 1 and turn.
- Work 1 dc in each stitch across.
- Repeat Row 2 until you have 20 rows in total.
- Fasten off.
- Repeat to make 6 identical squares.



STEP 2 – OPTIONAL BORDER

- Join yarn in any corner.
- Work 1 round of double crochet evenly around the square.
- Work 3 dc into each corner.
- Slip stitch to the first stitch to finish.
- Fasten off.
- Repeat for all six squares.



STEP 3 – ASSEMBLE

- Arrange 5 squares into a cross shape.
- Sew together using whip stitch or mattress stitch.
- Attach the sixth square.
- Leave one side open.



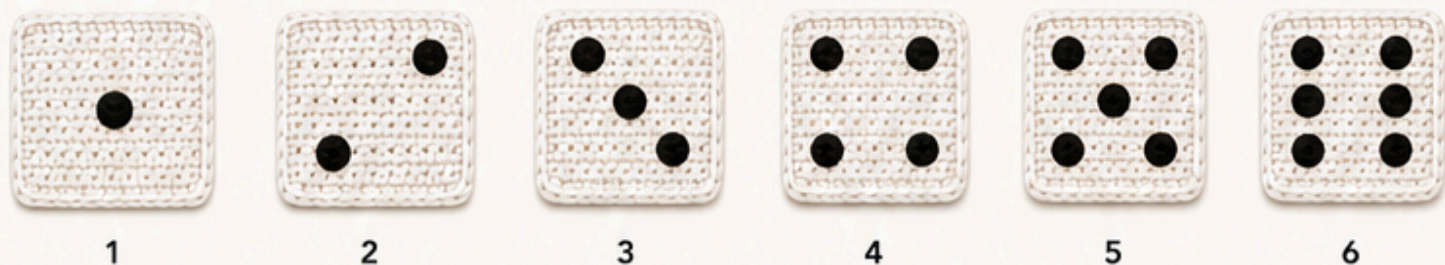
STEP 4 – STUFF

- Fill firmly with toy stuffing.
- Insert a small rattle if desired.
- Sew the final side closed.



STEP 5 – EMBROIDER THE DICE DOTS

Using black yarn, embroider the dots onto each face. Use French knots, satin stitch, or another embroidery stitch of your choice.



TIPS



Use tight, even stitches to avoid gaps.



Keep stitches consistent for a neat cube shape.



Weave in all ends securely.



Ensure all parts are secure for safety, especially for babies and toddlers.
